Centenary HQ Project Update

The Fund Raising Committee has been very busy during the summer and I am very pleased to announce we have now raised, once all pledges and donations have been received, in the region of £70,000 towards our new HQ project.

In particular I have to say a very big thank you to a very generous donation from a parent of the group who at this year's family camp pledged £10,000. This is a phenomenal and much welcome gesture and whilst the family would like to remain anonymous on behalf of the entire Scout Group we convey a very big thank you for your support. Other donations include the following:

- Ware Skillman Charity £500
- HCVYS £1,542.19 towards a new kitchen

In addition we have received £120 from ex scouts and their families. Selling Burgers at Ware Week raised £462 and the Family Camp in June raised a staggering £1,200. Finally we have received notice of a further sizeable donation which has pushed our total to approximately £70,000. We hope to be able to confirm this pledge and provide further details very soon.

A big thank you to everyone who helped, participated, pledged and donated funds - we have made significant progress and the Committee now have a renewed enthusiasm to take its efforts to the next level in meeting its goal of a new HQ for the 100 year centenary celebrations of Scouting in August 2007.
